The unit must be demonstrated to be fully functional and the operator(s) must receive training prior to acceptance of the unit. Operators will be defined as those employees who are currently skilled in operating equipment used in the collection of leaf and limb debris.

BID REQUIREMENTS

Purpose of Form
