SCOPE

The City of Sandersville is seeking bids from qualified vendors for three (3) sets of Firefighting Bunker Gear (PPE) for firefighting purposes to be worn by Firefighters in IDLH environments. All materials and construction will meet or exceed NFPA Standard #1971 and OSHA for structural fire fighters protective clothing. The Firefighting Bunker Gear must include jacket, pants, suspenders, boots, helmet, helmet shield, and particulate hood. Winning bidder will come to the Sandersville Fire Department located at 125 Warthen Street, Sandersville, GA 31082 to measure all personnel for the order.

The City of Sandersville reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids and act in the best interest of the City of Sandersville.

Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. Examples of information returns include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Form 1099-DIV (dividends, including those from stocks or mutual funds)
- Form 1099-MISC (various types of income, prizes, awards, or gross proceeds)
